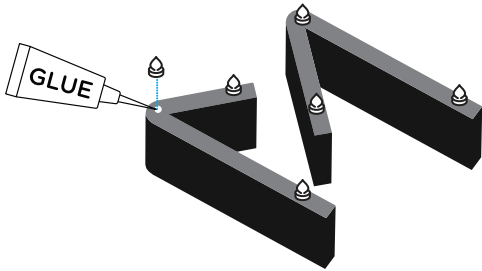

- Dimensional Letters
 - EZ-Snap Mounts
(Head Cap & Body will be separate)
 - Installation Template

- YOU WILL NEED**
- Super Glue
 - Level
 - Painter's Tape

STEP 1: Prepare the EZ-Snaps

Use super glue to adhere the head cap to the back of the letters. Pin dots may be printed on the back of the letters to guide your placement, or if provided, you may reference the design document for suggested placement. Generally, use one EZ-Snap about every 4", doing your best to obscure them from obvious view. Refer to your adhesive's directions for drying and curing time before proceeding with installation.



NOTE: If you have more than one depth or diameter size of EZ-Snaps, make sure you sort them correctly before applying to the appropriate letters.

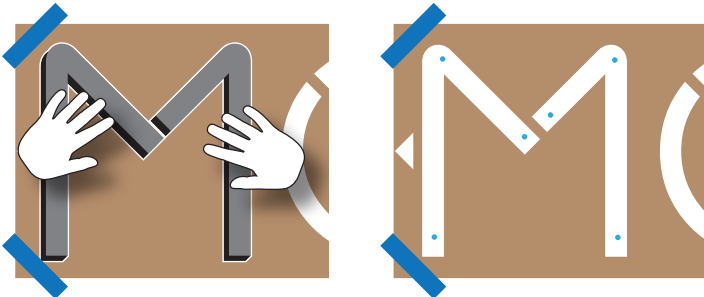
STEP 2: Place the installation template

Place the template where you want the graphic on the wall. Use the guide arrows on the template and a level to make sure it's straight. When you are happy with the placement, adhere the template to the wall using your painter's tape.

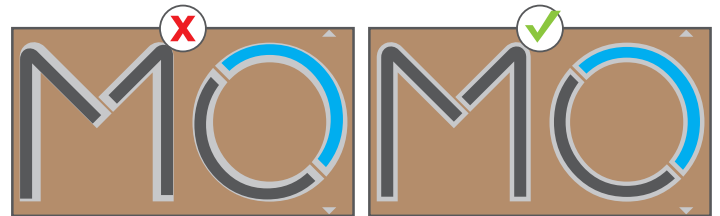


STEP 3: Use prepared letters to mark the wall

Once the adhesive has cured, place the letter in the template. Use pressure so that the points of the head caps mark a faint placement of the pilot holes. Repeat for all letters.

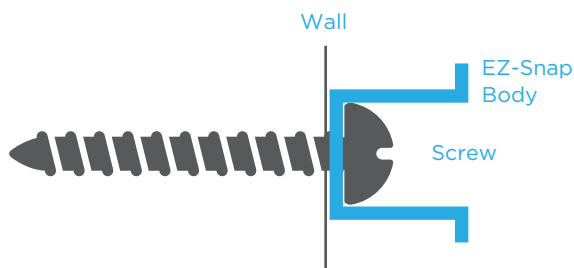


NOTE: To ensure accurate placement, make sure all letters are centered within the template outlines and not askew.



STEP 4: Install the EZ-Snap bodies

Using 3/4" screws, screw the click-snap bodies in place using the marks you made. Do not over tighten the screws. Use drywall anchors (not included) if necessary for your wall type. Repeat for all impressions you made in the previous step.



STEP 5: Install the letters

Line up the letter's head caps to the installed bodies and securely snap the letter in place with just enough pressure to fasten them.



Remove the template from the wall and store in a safe place in case the sign needs future maintenance.
