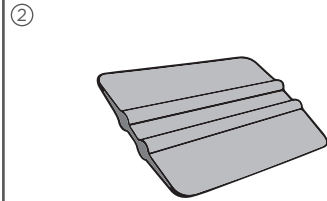

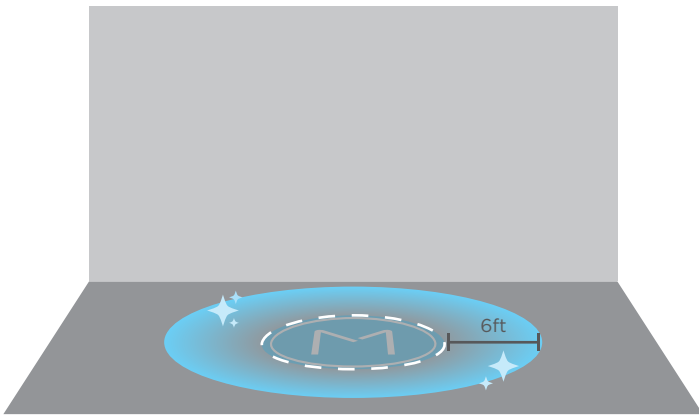

\*A round floor graphic is used as an example in these instructions. However, the following steps still apply if your floor graphic is not round.

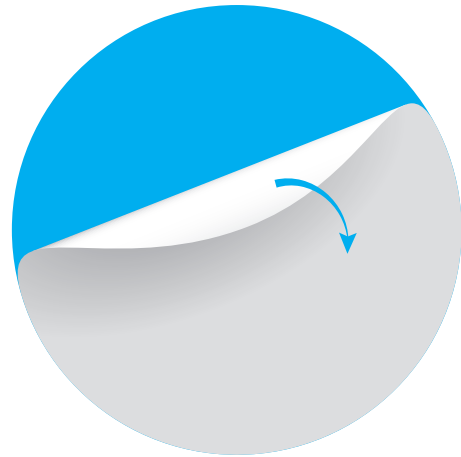
**INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

**STEP 1**



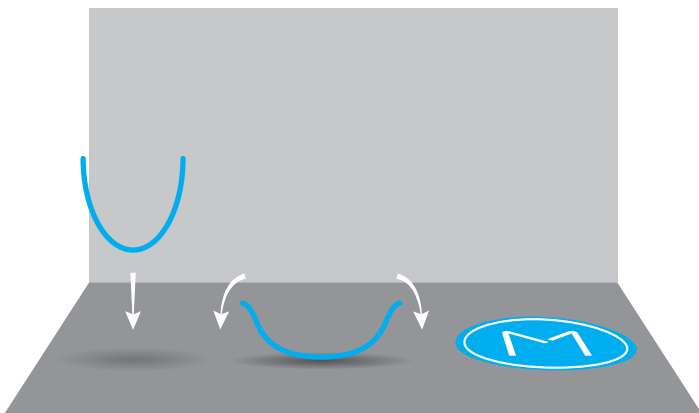
Plan where your graphic will go and then prepare the floor so that it is clean and dry. If possible, clean about six feet beyond the edges of where the graphic will go to help avoid debris blowing in during application.

**STEP 2**



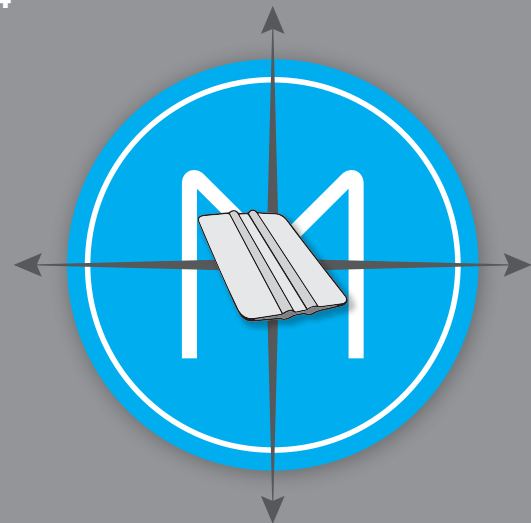
Pull the paper backing completely off of the graphic.

**STEP 3**



With the adhesive side of the graphic facing down, loosely drape the graphic so that the center of the graphic makes contact with the floor first, letting the rest of the graphic unfold from there.

**STEP 4**



Use the squeegee to adhere the graphic to the floor and get out any air bubbles, using strokes that start from the center of the graphic out to the edges.
